SB277, Nevada Environmental Policy Act, requires state agencies to prepare environmental reports that analyze the environmental impact of an agency activity. The Division of Environmental Protection (DEP) issues environmental permits and other actions that would fall under the purview of this Act. In addition, the Act requires that an agency with jurisdiction by law or special expertise shall act as a cooperating agency to participate in the scoping process and develop information and prepare an environmental analysis for those portions of the environmental impact statement related to its jurisdiction. As the primary environmental regulatory agency for the state, DEP envisions that its role as a cooperating agency would be significant. The fiscal note is based on personnel costs to staff 5 NEPA teams – 2 for water, 2 for air and 1 for other issues. The fiscal note includes only personnel cost and does not include personnel related cost such as rent, travel and operating.
