The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR # 24-926 which raises the penalty for violation of Sections 1, 4, and 5 of NRS 293.800. Instead of a category E felony, it will be a category D felony: a) for a person to provide false answers for one self or another person on the voter's registration application; b) for a person to pretend to be an eligible elector on or before the next ensuing election; c) for a field registrar or another individual to accept an application from a person who knowingly pretends to be an eligible elector or who provides false information. The NDOC has not admitted any offenders for violation of NRS 293.800 in the past 33 months; thus, the increase in the penalty shouldn't have an impact on the size of the prison population.
