BDR 38-193 (AB268) (Redo 2) requires licensees of foster homes to conduct fingerprint-based background and personnel history checks of persons 18 years of age or older who routinely supervise a child(ren) within a foster home. Because the General Services Division (GSD) has no way to estimate the number of individuals this requirement could cover, and thus no way to estimate the additional number of fingerprint submissions that may be required, a definitive cost estimate cannot be provided at this time. The cumulative impact to the division's Criminal History Repository resulting from applicant submission of fingerprint based background checks must be considered. GSD requests to return to the Nevada Legislature's Interim Finance Committee in the 2016-2017 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing. Pursuant to Public Law 92-544, as a condition of releasing its criminal history records, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) will need to review and approve the language of this bill.
