Staff for the Board of Pharmacy reviewed the draft of BDR 40-214 and determined that Sections 8 and 9 will require the Board to create significant new regulations regarding dispensing by unlicensed persons pursuant to an order issued by a health care professional, and for dispensing by pharmacists without a prescription (which pharmacists generally cannot do). Those regulations will have to establish procedures, protocols and education standards.

The bill will, therefore, have a fiscal impact on the Board of Pharmacy
