The fiscal impact to the agency could be significant based on potential litigation costs and the additional evaluation required of applicants and enforcement actions to determine the applicability of the provisions of AB269. It is estimated that the provisions of this bill would affect approximately 30% of applicants and licensees, 18% of enforcement actions against licensed contractors, and 95% of enforcement actions against unlicensed contractors. This would result in increased investigative and processing costs of approximately \$316,108. We conservatively estimate that litigation costs could run between \$150,000 and \$250,000 annually.
