BDR 54-668 (AB311) relating to mortgage lending. If enacted, this bill as it relates to the General Services Division (GSD) Criminal History Repository will amend and/or repeal existing law within NRS 645B and 645E. Proposed amendments include the repeal of NRS 645B.020 and 645B.410 that would reduce the number of fingerprint based background checks and amended language to NRS 645E.200 that would increase the number of fingerprint based background checks. Because the GSD has no way to estimate the number of individuals these requirements could cover, and thus no way to estimate the additional number of fingerprint submissions that may be required, a definitive cost estimate cannot be provided at this time. The cumulative impact to the division's Criminal History Repository resulting from the increase of applicant submission of fingerprint based background must be considered. GSD requests to return to the Nevada Legislature's Interim Finance Committee in the 2016-2017 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
