This agency has reviewed BDR 40-32 which, in addition to other provisions, prohibits insurers from refusing to sell, provide or issue a policy of health insurance or life insurance or charging a higher rate because of a person makes or revokes a request for a controlled substance designed to end the life of the person. Although the Public Employees' Benefits Program does not have an exclusion for these medications, the plan does have quantity limits for certain classes of medications. This requirement may have a fiscal impact on PEBP; however the cost cannot be determined at this time.
