BDR 15-73 Revises provisions relating to human trafficking; Section 38 provides that upon request from a person whom a peace officer reasonably believes to be a victim of human trafficking, the peace officer must provide the person certain forms from the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services. As the bill is written, the Training Division for the Department of Public Safety will create a four to six hour online training course to provide necessary training and information to law enforcement officers to know how to identify qualifying victims and what information to provide to those victims. Additionally, the law enforcement officer will be required to take time away from his or her primary duties to complete the required training. However, the Department of Public Safety, Director's Office, has determined that there is no fiscal impact for the peace officer related sections of this bill.
