The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR 15-73. The Department hasn't admitted any offenders for violation of NRS 200.463 to 200.469 since June 2012. This means that if the existing NRS states that it is unlawful to engage in trafficking in persons or to force a person into involuntary servitude are streamlined into a new act, and the penalties are revised, there should be no impact on the prison population. Offenders convicted of trafficking in humans and sexual servitude will be Tier II sex offenders. In order to apply the proposed laws, the NDOC might have to update its forms with the new wording; however, this shouldn't result in a significant financial impact.
