Section 1 of this legislation eliminates all exemptions for state agencies from the rulemaking requirements in the Nevada Administrative Procedures Act except the Governor. The provision would increase the agencies that are required to submit permanent regulations for drafting to the Legal Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau. As a result, the legislation would require the addition of two Deputy Legislative Counsel positions.

Although the additional regulation drafting requirements would result in additional reimbursements from some of the state agencies that are not currently required to submit their regulations to the Legal Division for review, the additional revenues will not be sufficient to cover the costs of the positions. As a result, additional General Fund appropriations would be required to offset the difference between the additional reimbursements and the cost of the positions.
