The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR # 14-846 which provides for the restoration of the right to possess a firearm for an ex-offender that meets select criteria. If an ex-offender is granted the right to own or possess a firearm, he or she will be immediately restored the right to vote, serve as a juror in a civil criminal action, or to hold office if these rights haven't been restored. If the proposed law passes, the NDOC will need to educate its case management and re-entry staff about the change in the restoration of civil rights and the right to possess a firearm, when applicable, after a period of post-incarceration or post-conviction. This is a procedural change that should impose no significant fiscal impact on the department.
