BDR 18-843 requires all state agencies to comply with the established rulemaking requirements when adopting regulations and eliminates all state agency exemptions, except for the Governor. The BDR also amends NRS 233B.067 to require the review of adopted permanent regulations by the Legislative Commission or the Subcommittee to occur only during a regular Legislative Session, unless required by specific statute. If a permanent regulation is not approved and subsequently revised and resubmitted to the Legislative Counsel, the regulation can only be submitted to the Legislative Commission for review, if the Legislature is in regular session. There is no change in the process for adopting temporary regulations.

As written, the BDR has no immediate fiscal impact. However, it will delay the process for adopting regulations which may impede the implementation of state and federal mandates even if regulations are not required by statute.
