#### Explanation

The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology has reviewed BDR 54-1050 and found that it will have a fiscal impact. The inspection time at each cosmetological establishment that has a makeup artist will require significantly more time to complete. Since all other licensees are required to have a license with their photograph posted at their station, it is easy for an inspector (and the public) to determine if a person is licensed, visually identify them, and know when their license expires. At a salon having a registered makeup artist the inspector will have to ask for photo identification, contact the Board office to certify that the person is registered, and finally certify that their registration is current. These additional steps are the estimated equivalent of requiring another 30% inspection time (and another inspector hired) for the agency.
