BDR 14-846 (AB357) relating to criminal procedure; authorizing certain persons who are prohibited from owning, possessing or having under their custody or control any firearm to petition the court to restore their right to own, possess and control any firearm is restored; authorizing a prosecuting attorney to inquire into, inspect and use as evidence certain sealed records in certain circumstances; adding a person who has been convicted of a crime that constitutes domestic violence to the list of persons who are prohibited from owning or having in their possession or under their custody or control any firearm. If enacted, as written this bill will impact the General Services Division (GSD) of the Department of Public Safety significantly. GSD will see program impacts within its Brady Firearm Background Unit in addition to the Fingerprint Support Unit – Record Seals Unit. The result of the numerous program impacts would necessitate increased staffing due to the significant change in current processes within these units. This fiscal note includes the costs for the addition of six permanent full time positions including the necessary operating and startup costs within each of these units.
