This legislation would create a new subcommittee of the Advisory Commission on the Administration of Justice and would eliminate an existing subcommittee of the Advisory Commission. The Governor's recommended budget includes \$4,746 in each year of the 2015-17 biennium for the costs of the Advisory Commission and its subcommittees. It appears that since the net result of this legislation would be to have the same number of subcommittees as there are currently, there would be no fiscal impact. However, historically the Advisory Commission has been tasked with different requirements as legislation is finalized each legislative session. The Legislative Counsel Bureau will continue to monitor the workload that is placed on the Advisory Commission as the session progresses and will notify the Legislature if the workload results in a need for additional funding.
