BDR 58-633 (SB439) Redo 2 provides for the permitting and regulation of transportation network companies. Section 14 of this bill establishes requirements prior to a driver connected to potential passengers. One of which requires a transportation network company to conduct or contract with a third party to conduct an investigation of the criminal history of each driver. The General Services Division (GSD) of the Department of Public Safety does not anticipate a fiscal impact as currently written. Also, if this bill is enacted, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) will need to review and approve the language pursuant to Public Law 92-544.
