The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR 24-1146. NRS 2093.800 dictates that it is unlawful for an individual to forge his or her registration to vote to appear as being an eligible elector. Furthermore, the NRS points that is unlawful for a field registrar or another individual to contribute to the submission of an application with false information or to submit an incomplete application to the county clerk. This bill increases the penalty for violation of NRS 293.800 from a category E to a D felony. Research staff looked for prison population records with convictions under several related NRS, such as 293.800, 293.505, 293.710, 293.780, or 293.805 and no offenders were found. Thus, it is assumed that these cases don't typically result in felony convictions, and passage of the bill should not have a significant impact on the NDOC.
