The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR 15-85. Section 1 of the bill modifies NRS 207.335 to add that it is a category E felony to counterfeit, forge or, or have possession with the intent to use a counterfeit registry card for the use of medical marijuana. The NDOC shouldn't be impacted by passage of this section, given that no offenders have been incarcerated since medical marijuana has been legalized. Section 7 of this bill will prohibit a law enforcement agency from adopting policies and procedures that would prevent a peace officer from using medical marijuana. The officer's job duties would

have to be adjusted, when possible. The NDOC employs peace officers to work in custody positions, and if required to comply with the proposed law, it will have to apply its policies based on the State of Nevada Human Resource Management regulations. Until then, the impact of this section cannot be determined
