BDR 14-559 (SB454) relating to criminal justice. Section 17, subsection 1, will require the General Services Division (GSD) to collaborate with the Court Administrator, the State Bar of Nevada, law enforcement agencies, district judges, district attorneys, county clerks, justices of the peace and municipal judges to develop recommended policies and procedures to implement a statewide criminal justice information sharing database. Because the GSD has no way to determine the requirements of GSD in relationship to the implementation of a statewide database and how this system would differ from its current Nevada Criminal Justice Information System (NCJIS), a definitive cost estimate cannot be provided at this time. NCJIS is the computerized information system created to serve all state, federal, and local law enforcement and criminal justice agencies in Nevada maintained by the General Services Division. NCJIS is the conduit through which Nevada criminal justice agencies access information systems of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and other states. GSD requests to return to the Nevada Legislature's Interim Finance Committee in 2016 -2017 should workload and/or program needs necessitate additional staffing or information technology functionality.
