This measure authorizes the establishment of an Individual Graduation Plan (IGP) for certain pupils enrolled in high school. The State Superintendent determines the maximum number of students who may have an IGP. Students with an IGP may remain in high school for up to 18 months after the date he/she was scheduled to graduate to meet certain graduation requirements.

This measure will increase the enrollment count by accounting for students who remain in high school longer than the usual four years, thus impacting the Distributive School Account (DSA). The fiscal impact to the DSA cannot be determined, as the number of students authorized for an IGP is not known at this time.
