The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR #54-1147 which creates the Nevada Residential Mortgage Servicer Licensing and Regulatory Act. If passed it will be a category D to violate the provisions of this act when the amount involved is at least \$1,000. The crime will be punishable with one to four years in a state prison. The NDOC evaluated the provisions of this bill, searched its records, and learned that no individuals have been incarcerated in the past three years due to failure to comply with mortgage servicing requirements. Thus, it is assumed that amendements to NRS 645A and the creation of a regulatory act won't have a substantive impact on the NDOC.
