The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR # 52-1168 which revises NRS 598.096 in regards to seizure of property of a business that is engaging in a deceptive trade practice. Passage of the bill will require a hearing and seizure will be pursued if it is necessary to protect the public or the public's interest. It will be a category B felony to engage in deceptive trade practices that resulted in charges of theft or racketeering (NRS 598.0999). The Nevada Department of Corrections searched its database and concluded that it hasn't incarcerated a single offender for violation of NRS 598.0999 in the past three years. It is assumed that violators are convicted of breaching NRS 205.083 which addresses theft in multiple forms. Thus, passage of the proposed law shouldn't have a substantive impact.
