The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR S-1207. Section 22 of the bill removes \$253,000 in reserves from the Fund for Facilities for New Construction of Prison Industries, and diverts those funds to the General Fund to offset the difference between projected revenues and collections. This is a one-time sweep in response to the projected 2015 inability to make the 5% reserve requirement for the State General Fund, and is not expected to have an impact beyond the one-time sweep.
