BDR 34-1090 (SB509) relating to education. Section 7, subsection 1 requires each member of a governing body of a charter school to forward a set of fingerprints to the General Services Division (GSD), Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History within ten days after being appointed to the governing body. Because the GSD has no way to estimate the number of individuals this requirement could cover, and thus no way to estimate the additional number of fingerprint submission that may be required, a definitive cost estimate cannot be provided at this time. Also, if enacted the FBI will need to review and approve the language pursuant to Public Law 92-544 as a condition of releasing its criminal history records. GSD requests to return to the Nevada Legislature's Interim Finance Committee in the 2016-2017 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
