Sections 7-12 and 50-55 further prescribe certain duties of a voter registration agency. Existing law designates the offices of certain governmental agencies as voter registration agencies which are required to offer applications to register to vote to persons who apply for or receive services from the agency, to assist applicants in completing the applications and to forward the applications to the county clerk. The Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS) is a voter registration agency. This bill establishes procedures by which a voter registration agency transmits certain information in order to register a person to vote or to correct information contained in the statewide voter registration list. This bill would require DWSS to create a process and procedure for electronically transmitting voter registration applications and declinations to the SoS. It would entail moderate modifications to the Access Nevada application and a data transfer to an application that the SoS is tasked with developing. Currently voter declination information is not gathered and it is unclear if there is another form that will be required to be completed for this process. The cost for these modifications may be impacted by the final system for data transmission developed by the SoS.
