Comment: In the event that this bill draft was to pass, Alternative School Performance Framework would have impact for our alternative schools. The plan for the framework would include behavior/continuation schools, credit retrieval schools, special schools, and correctional schools. CCSD has approximately 20 schools that would need a pre/post assessment program such as Plato Learning. Estimated cost per site license is \$10,000 per site license. Also required would be a social or resiliency curriculum such as Success Highways estimated at \$8,000 per site license. Estimated impact for site licenses is \$360,000 annually. The other area of potential impact is the requirement that charter sponsors must provide assistance to improve performance at charter schools if the charter requests assistance. Due to lack of clarity regarding what assistance would need to be provided or what could actually be requested, CCSD cannot accurately indicate if a cost would be needed to assist the small existing charter operation staff or other CCSD units. Charter schools should be autonomous and self-supporting other than "reasonable" technical assistance.
