Bill Draft Request(BDR)41-353 creates or enhances criminal penalties which could impact the Department of Public Safety, Division of Parole & Probation. The BDR does not contain sufficient information to determine if there would be a caseload increase; therefore, the fiscal impact cannot be determined.
