RE: Senate Bill 183 of the 78<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session

Dear Secretary of State Cegavske:

I am forwarding to you, for filing within the time limit set forth in the Nevada Constitution and without my approval, Senate Bill 183, which is entitled:

AN ACT relating to motor carriers; revising the declaration of legislative purpose and policy governing the regulation of certain motor carriers; revising the criteria for granting or modifying certificates of public convenience and necessity for certain motor carriers; revising provisions governing participation as an intervener in a hearing on an application for such a certificate; revising provisions governing the filing of an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity by a person whose previous application has been denied; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Senate Bill 183 seeks to eliminate procedures and policies in Nevada law that govern the Nevada Transportation Authority's ability to oversee and ensure that a motor carrier operator always transports members of the public safely. The Nevada Transportation Authority's ability to consider the economic viability of a motor carrier operator is an important factor in evaluating whether that operator has the necessary resources to transport members of the public safely and can maintain industry safety standards. Therefore, I veto this bill and return it without my signature or approval.
