S.B. 26 (R1) Makes certain changes concerning governmental entities that contract with or invest in companies that boycott Israel. (BDR 27-418)

<u>S.B. 78</u> (R1)	Revises provisions relating to local government financial administration. (BDR 31-403)
<u>S.B. 127</u> (R1)	Revises provisions relating to the election of members of certain local governing bodies. (BDR 20-786)
<u>S.B. 191</u> (R1)	Establishes a standard for evidence of eligibility for any benefit, program or assistance provided to a veteran with a military service-connected disability. (BDR 37-803)
<u>S.B. 236 (R1)</u>	Requires a license or permit issued by a local government to operate certain businesses in which the use of marijuana is allowed or to allow the use of marijuana at certain events. (BDR 20-43)
<u>S.B. 245</u> (R1)	Revises provisions governing county treasurers. (BDR 20-599)
<u>S.B. 375</u> (R1)	Authorizes agreements between the Governor and Indian tribes in this State relating to the regulation of the use of marijuana. (BDR 18-321)
<u>S.B. 429</u> (R1)	Establishes provisions relating to urban agriculture. (BDR 22-1078)

S.B. 434 Requires certain city attorneys to be appointed rather than elected.
