<u>S.B. 551</u>	Establishes for the 2017-2019 biennium the subsidies to be paid to the Public Employees' Benefits Program for insurance for certain active and retired public officers and employees. (BDR S-1242)
<u>S.B. 552</u>	Revises provisions governing the cost of certain coverage under the Public Employees' Benefits Program. (BDR 23-1226)
<u>A.B. 505 (</u> R1)	Makes appropriations to the Department of Corrections for a new telephone system and certain information systems projects. (BDR S-1200)
<u>A.B. 506</u> (R1)	Makes appropriations to the Nevada Gaming Control Board for certain costs relating to the Alpha Migration Project. (BDR S-1201)
<u>A.B. 507</u> (R1)	Makes appropriations to the Department of Public Safety for the replacement of vehicles, pickup trucks and motorcycles for the Nevada Highway Patrol. (BDR S-1202)
<u>A.B. 508 (</u> R1)	Makes an appropriation to the Department of Public Safety for the replacement of dispatch center consoles and portable hand-held radios. (BDR S-1203)

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- A.B. 509 (R1) Makes an appropriation to the Department of Business and Industry for implementation of an electronic management system for public works and prevailing wage surveys in the Office of the Labor Commissioner. (BDR S-1207)
- A.B. 510 (R1) Makes appropriations to the Bureau of Services to Persons Who Are Blind or Visually Impaired of the Rehabilitation Division of the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation and the Bureau of Vocational Rehabilitation of the Rehabilitation Division of the Department for enhancement of client information systems.
