

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 128—ASSEMBLYWOMAN SPIEGEL

SUMMARY—Exempts certain unpaid individuals from the requirement to obtain licensure as a process server. (BDR 54-700)

AN ACT relating to service of process; exempting certain unpaid individuals from the requirement to obtain licensure as a process server; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law requires a person who engages in the business of a process server
2 to obtain a license. (NRS 648.060) Existing law defines engaging in such business
3 to include a single act. (NRS 648.063) This bill exempts any person who without
4 compensation serves legal process from the requirements of chapter 648 of NRS
5 relating to process servers, including, without limitation, the requirement to obtain
6 a license to engage in the business of a process server.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 648.063 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 648.063 ~~Am~~
3 *1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, an*
4 *unlicensed person who performs a single act for which a license is*
5 *required has engaged in the business for which the license is*
6 *required and, unless exempt from licensing or performing an*
7 *investigation pursuant to NRS 253.220, has violated NRS 648.060.*
8 *2. A natural person who without compensation serves legal*
9 *process must not be deemed to be engaged in the business of*
10 *process server and the provisions of this chapter relating to*



- 1 *process servers, including, without limitation, the requirement to*
- 2 *obtain a license to engage in the business of process server*
- 3 *pursuant to NRS 648.060, do not apply to such a person.*
