SUMMARY—Authorizes a lessor of a motortruck to impose certain additional charges. (BDR 43-52)

AN ACT relating to lessors of motortrucks; authorizing a lessor of a motortruck to impose certain additional charges; requiring a lessor of a motortruck who wishes to impose an additional charge to disclose the amount of the additional charge in a price quote or estimate provided by the lessor; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 **Section 1** of this bill authorizes a lessor of a motortruck to impose an additional  
2 charge to recover any costs incurred by the lessor in conducting his or her business.  
3 Any such additional charges must be disclosed at the time the lessor provides a  
4 price quote or estimate for the lease of the motortruck. Existing law makes a  
5 violation of this provision a misdemeanor. (NRS 482.555)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 482 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***1. A lessor of a motortruck may impose an additional charge***  
4 ***to recover any costs incurred by the lessor in conducting his or her***  
5 ***business.***

6 ***2. If a lessor of a motortruck wishes to impose an additional***  
7 ***charge pursuant to subsection 1, the lessor shall, at the time he or***



1 *she provides a price quote or estimate for the lease of the*  
2 *motortruck to the lessee of the motortruck, disclose the existence*  
3 *of the additional charge and include the amount of the additional*  
4 *charge in the price quote or estimate.*

5 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2017.
