ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION—Adding former Assemblyman Lynn
Hettrick to the Assembly Wall of Distinction.

1 WHEREAS, The Assembly of the Legislature of the State of
2 Nevada has established a Wall of Distinction for those past
3 members of the Assembly, selected by leadership, who served with
4 great distinction and who made exemplary contributions to the State
5 of Nevada; and

6 WHEREAS, Lynn C. Hettrick was born in Carmel, California, in
7 1944 and attended Claremont Men's College before pursuing a
8 career as an entrepreneur and investment manager; and

9 WHEREAS, After moving to Gardnerville, Nevada, in 1970,
10 Lynn Hettrick became deeply involved in the community and civic
11 affairs; and

12 WHEREAS, In 1992, Lynn Hettrick was elected to the Nevada
13 Assembly representing District 39 where he served with distinction
14 for 14 years; and

15 WHEREAS, During the 1995 Session, the Assembly, for the first
16 time in the history of Nevada, was evenly divided with 21
17 Republicans and 21 Democrats and Lynn Hettrick was elected as
18 Co-Speaker, sharing that office with Assemblyman Joseph E. (Joe)
19 Dini Jr.; and

20 WHEREAS, Despite the great potential for conflict, Lynn
21 Hettrick led his party in a manner that made the 1995 Session
22 become regarded as one of the least contentious and smoothest
23 running sessions; and

24 WHEREAS, Lynn Hettrick went on to serve as Assembly
25 Minority Floor Leader from 1997 to 2005; and



1 WHEREAS, During his service in the Assembly, Lynn Hettrick
2 served on numerous standing committees, including 12 years on the
3 Committee on Ways and Means and the Interim Finance
4 Committee; and

5 WHEREAS, Lynn Hettrick represented Nevada on several
6 national organizations, serving as Chair of the Council of State
7 Governments (CSG) and of CSG West where he was instrumental in
8 establishing the Western Legislative Academy to provide training
9 for new legislators; and

10 WHEREAS, After leaving the Legislature, Lynn Hettrick went on
11 to serve as Deputy Chief of Staff for former Governor Jim Gibbons;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, Lynn Hettrick was selected in 2008 by the Board of
14 Regents of the University of Nevada to receive the Distinguished
15 Nevadan award, an honor bestowed on prominent individuals for
16 significant achievements in the cultural, scientific or social
17 advancement of Nevada; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, That,
19 for his 14 years of dedicated service to the Assembly, Lynn C.
20 Hettrick is hereby added to the Assembly Wall of Distinction; and
21 be it further

22 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and
23 transmit a copy of this resolution to former Assemblyman Lynn C.
24 Hettrick.
