SUMMARY—Creates the Task Force on the Economics of the Middle Class in Nevada. (BDR S-820)

AN ACT relating to the middle class; creating the Task Force on the Economics of the Middle Class in Nevada to conduct a study during the 2017-2018 interim on the economics and economic mobility of middle-class Nevadans; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 This bill creates the Task Force on the Economics of the Middle Class in Nevada,
2 consisting of: (1) three representatives from the Assembly; (2) three representatives from the
3 Senate; (3) one member appointed by the Governor; (4) three members who represent
4 chambers of commerce or business communities in the different geographic areas of this
5 State; ~~and~~ (5) ***three members who represent labor organizations or labor communities***
6 ***in the different geographic areas of this State; and*** (6) one member who represents a legal
7 aid program. The Task Force must conduct a study during the 2017-2018 legislative interim
8 on the middle class in Nevada. The Task Force must submit a report of its findings and
9 recommendations to the Legislative Commission.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby created the Task Force on the Economics of
2 the Middle Class in Nevada, consisting of:

3 (a) Three members of the Assembly, two of whom are appointed by the
4 Speaker of the Assembly and one of whom is appointed by the Minority Leader of
5 the Assembly;

6 (b) Three members of the Senate, two of whom are appointed by the Majority
7 Leader of the Senate and one of whom is appointed by the Minority Leader of the
8 Senate;

9 (c) One member appointed by the Governor;

10 (d) Three members appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly, each of whom
11 represents a chamber of commerce or the business community from a different
12 geographic region of this State; ~~and~~

13 (e) Three members appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly, each of
14 whom represents a labor organization or the labor community from a
15 different geographic region of this State; and

16 (f) One member appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly who represents a
17 program for legal aid organized under the auspices of the State Bar of Nevada.

18 2. A vacancy on the Task Force must be filled in the same manner as the
19 original appointment.

20 3. The Speaker of the Assembly shall appoint as Chair of the Task Force one
21 of the members appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly pursuant to paragraph
22 (a) of subsection 1.

23 4. A majority of the members of the Task Force constitutes a quorum for the
24 transaction of business, and a majority of those members present at any meeting is
25 sufficient for any official action taken by the Task Force.

26 5. While engaged in the business of the Task Force, to the extent that money
27 is available for that purpose, the members of the Task Force are entitled to receive
28 the per diem allowance and travel expenses provided for state officers and
29 employees generally.

30 6. The Task Force shall:

31 (a) Conduct a study during the 2017-2018 interim on the economics and
32 economic mobility of the middle class in Nevada.

33 (b) For the purposes of conducting the interim study, define what it means to
34 be middle class in Nevada.

35 (c) Determine the factors that affect whether a person is in the middle class,
36 including, without limitation, age, race, level of education and familial and marital
37 status.

38 (d) Establish objective and quantifiable indicators of whether a person is in the
39 middle class.

40 (e) Study and make recommendations for legislation in the following subjects,
41 without limitation, that is designed to improve the financial and living conditions of
42 the middle class:

43 (1) Workforce and job development, including, without limitation,
44 employee support and support of small and start-up businesses;

45 (2) Education, including, without limitation, preschool and K-12 programs,
46 including, without limitation, programs in financial literacy;

47 (3) Health care, including, without limitation, access to physical and
48 mental health care;

49 (4) Housing, including, without limitation, home-buying programs; and

1 (5) Transportation.

2 7. In fulfillment of its mission, the Task Force may solicit information on
3 the economics and demographics of this State from the institutions of higher
4 education within the Nevada System of Higher Education.

5 8. The Task Force shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations
6 to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the Legislative
7 Commission.

8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2017.
