SUMMARY—Revises provisions concerning certain communications relating to elections. (BDR ~~12-85~~ 24-85)

AN ACT relating to elections; ~~[prohibiting a public officer or employee from using official stationery for certain purposes relating to elections;]~~ requiring a disclosure on certain elections-related communications; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law ~~[prohibits a public officer or employee from using governmental time, property, equipment or other facility to benefit a significant personal or pecuniary interest of the public officer or employee, unless certain exceptions apply.]~~ (NRS 281A.400) Existing law
2 also prohibits a public officer or employee from requesting or otherwise causing a governmental entity to incur an expense or make an expenditure to support or oppose a ballot
3 question or candidate. (NRS 281A.520) Section 1 of this bill expressly prohibits a public
4 officer or employee from using official stationery from a state or local governmental entity to
5 express support for or opposition to a candidate, committee for political action, political party,
6 committee sponsored by a political party or ballot question or to solicit a contribution or a
7 commitment to make a contribution for any political purpose; ~~[requires that certain types of~~
8 294A.347-294A.349] If a communication that is published in support of or in opposition to a
9 candidate includes the name and address or other contact information of a governmental
10 entity, section 2 of this bill requires that the communication disclose in a clear and
11 conspicuous manner that the communication was not published by the governmental entity.
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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** ~~[Chapter 281A of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:~~
2 *1. A public officer or employee shall not use official stationery to:*
3 *(a) Express support for or opposition to a candidate or group of candidates, committee for political action, political party, committee sponsored by a political party or ballot question; or*

1 **(b) Solicit a contribution or a commitment to make such a contribution for**
2 **any political purpose.**

3 **2. As used in this section:**

4 **(a) "Candidate" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 294A.005.**

5 **(b) "Committee for political action" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS**
6 **294A.0055.**

7 **(c) "Committee sponsored by a political party" has the meaning ascribed to it**
8 **in NRS 294A.0065.**

9 **(d) "Contribution" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 294A.007.**

10 **(e) "Official stationery" means stationery that contains any symbol, name,**
11 **word or mark of a state or local governmental entity, including, without**
12 **limitation, the Great Seal of the State of Nevada.] (Deleted by amendment.)**

13 Sec. 2. Chapter 294A of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new
14 section to read as follows:

15 1. **If a communication that is published in support of or in opposition to a**
16 **candidate includes the name and address or other contact information of a**
17 **governmental entity, the communication must disclose in a clear and**
18 **conspicuous manner that the communication was not published by the**
19 **governmental entity.**

20 2. **As used in this section:**

21 (a) **"Contact information" includes, without limitation, a telephone or**
22 **facsimile number and an electronic mail address.**

23 (b) **"Governmental entity" means an institution, board, commission, bureau,**
24 **council, department, division, office, authority or other unit of government of this**
25 **State, or a political subdivision thereof, including, without limitation, an**
26 **agency or public officer of this State or of a political subdivision.**

27 **H&P (c) "Publish" means the act of:**

28 (I) **Printing, posting, broadcasting, mailing or otherwise disseminating;**
29 **or**

30 (2) **Causing to be printed, posted, broadcasted, mailed or otherwise**
31 **disseminated.**
