SUMMARY—Revises provisions concerning certain communications relating to elections. (BDR ~~12-85~~) 24-85

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets ~~material~~ is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to elections; ~~prohibiting a public officer or employee from using official stationery for certain purposes relating to elections;~~ requiring a disclosure on certain elections-related communications; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law ~~prohibits a public officer or employee from using governmental time, property, equipment or other facility to benefit a significant personal or pecuniary interest of the public officer or employee, unless certain exceptions apply.~~ (NRS 281A.400) Existing law also prohibits a public officer or employee from requesting or otherwise causing a governmental entity to incur an expense or make an expenditure to support or oppose a ballot question or candidate. (NRS 281A.520) Section 1 of this bill expressly prohibits a public officer or employee from using official stationery from a state or local governmental entity to express support for or opposition to a candidate, committee for political action, political party, committee sponsored by a political party or ballot question or to solicit a contribution or a commitment to make a contribution for any political purpose. If ~~it requires that certain elections-related communications contain disclosures to provide the public with information relating to the source or purpose of the elections-related communications.~~ (NRS 294A.347-294A.349)

Section 2 of this bill provides that if an elections-related communication ~~that~~ is published in support of or in opposition to a candidate ~~and the communication~~ includes the **official** name and address ~~or other official contact information~~ of a governmental entity, ~~section 2 of this bill requires that of the State of Nevada or any political subdivision,~~ the communication **must** disclose in a clear and conspicuous manner that the communication ~~was not published by the governmental entity,~~ ~~is not endorsed by and is not an official publication of the State of Nevada or the political subdivision, as appropriate.~~

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** ~~Chapter 291A of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a~~

13 ~~(c) "Committee sponsored by a political party" has the meaning ascribed to it~~

15 ~~(d) "Contribution" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 2944.007.~~

16 ~~(e) "Official stationery" means stationery that contains any symbol, name,~~
17 ~~word or mark of a state or local governmental entity, including, without~~

19 Sec. 2. Chapter 294A of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new
20 section to read as follows:

21 **1. If a communication ~~that~~ is published in support of or in opposition to a**
22 **candidate and the communication includes the official name and address or**
23 **other official contact information of a governmental entity, the communication**
24 **must disclose in a clear and conspicuous manner ~~that~~ the following**
25 **information:**

26 **(a) If the communication ~~was not published by~~ includes the official name**
27 **and address or other official contact information of a governmental entity ~~of~~**
28 **of the State of Nevada, the communication must disclose:**

29 **This communication is not endorsed by and is not an official publication**
30 **of the State of Nevada.**

31 **(b) If the communication includes the official name and address or other**
32 **official contact information of a governmental entity of any political subdivision**
33 **of the State of Nevada, the communication must disclose:**

34 **This communication is not endorsed by and is not an official publication**
35 **of (insert the official name of the political subdivision).**

36 **2. As used in this section:**

37 **(a) "Governmental entity" means ~~the State of Nevada, any political~~**
38 **~~subdivision of the State of Nevada or any agency, institution, board, commission,~~**
39 **~~bureau, council, department, division, office, authority or other unit of~~**
40 **~~government of this State, including, without limitation, an agency of this State or~~**
41 **~~of the State of Nevada or any political subdivision ~~of~~ the State of Nevada.~~**

42 **(b) "Official name and address or other official contact information of a**
43 **governmental entity" means the legal or commonly recognized name of a**
44 **governmental entity and:**

1 (1) The street address of any building, office or other place where the
2 governmental entity is open for the transaction of official business; or

3 (2) Any other official contact information for contacting the
4 governmental entity for the transaction of official business, including, without
5 limitation, a telephone number, facsimile number, electronic mail address or
6 address of the Internet website of the governmental entity.

7 (c) "Publish" means the act of:

8 (1) Printing, posting, broadcasting, mailing or otherwise disseminating;
9 or

10 (2) Causing to be printed, posted, broadcasted, mailed or otherwise
11 disseminated.
