SUMMARY—Establishes a program to provide grants for family planning services. (BDR 40-630)

AN ACT relating to family planning; establishing a program to award grants to local governmental entities and nonprofit organizations for the purpose of providing certain services relating to family planning; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law authorizes the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the
2 Department of Health and Human Services to: (1) conduct a family planning service in any
3 county of this State; and (2) establish a policy of referral of certain persons for family
4 planning services. (NRS 422.308) **Section 5** of this bill establishes the Account for Family
5 Planning in the State General Fund and requires the Administrator of the Division of Public
6 and Behavioral Health of the Department of Health and Human Services to administer the
7 Account. **Section 5** requires the money in the Account to be expended to award grants of
8 money to local governmental entities and nonprofit organizations to be used to provide certain
9 services relating to family planning to persons who would otherwise have difficulty obtaining
10 those services. **Section 5 authorizes a local government that is awarded a grant to provide**
11 **such family planning services through a contract with another person or entity.** **Section**
12 **6** of this bill authorizes the Administrator to accept gifts, grants and donations for the purpose
13 of awarding such grants. **Section 7** of this bill requires the recipient of a grant to provide
14 certain information to a person to whom the recipient provides counseling that is funded by a
15 grant. **Sections 7 and 9** of this bill provide that any personally identifiable information
16 concerning a person to whom a grant recipient provides services is confidential. **Section 8** of
17 this bill requires the State Board of Health to adopt regulations concerning the award of
18 grants.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 442 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto the
2 provisions set forth as sections 2 to 8, inclusive, of this act.

3 **Sec. 2.** *As used in sections 2 to 8, inclusive of this act, unless the context
4 otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in sections 3 and 4 of this act
5 have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.*

6 **Sec. 3.** *"Account" means the Account for Family Planning created by
7 section 5 of this act.*

8 **Sec. 4.** *"Administrator" means the Administrator of the Division.*

9 **Sec. 5. 1.** *The Account for Family Planning is hereby created in the State
10 General Fund. The Administrator shall administer the Account.*

11 *2. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 12-4, the money in the
12 Account must be expended to award grants of money to local governmental
13 entities and nonprofit organizations to provide the family planning services
14 recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Office
15 of Population Affairs of the United States Department of Health and Human
16 Services, described in this section to persons who would otherwise have difficulty
17 obtaining such services because of poverty, lack of insurance or transportation or
18 any other reason. [Family planning services funded by grants] Grants of money
19 awarded pursuant to this section may include, without limitation, only be used
20 to fund:*

21 *(a) [Counseling] The provision of counseling by trained personnel
22 concerning family planning;*

23 *(b) [Distributing] The distribution of information concerning family
24 planning;*

25 *(c) [Referring] The referral of persons to appropriate agencies, organizations
26 and providers of health care for consultation, examination, treatment, genetic
27 counseling and prescriptions for the purpose of family planning;*

28 *(d) [Distributing drugs, contraceptive devices, thermometers, charts and
29 other products relating to family planning;] The distribution of contraceptives,
30 the installation of contraceptive devices and the performance of contraceptive
31 procedures approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration, which
32 must be limited to:*

33 *(1) Sterilization surgery for women;*

34 *(2) Surgical sterilization implants for women;*

35 *(3) Implantable rods;*

36 *(4) Copper intrauterine devices and intrauterine devices with progestin;*

37 *(5) Contraceptive injections and patches;*

38 *(6) Combined oral contraceptive pills, progestin only oral contraceptives
39 and oral contraceptives for extended or continuous use;*

40 *(7) Vaginal contraceptive rings;*

41 *(8) Diaphragms;*

42 *(9) Contraceptive sponges;*

43 *(10) Cervical caps;*

44 *(11) Female condoms;*

45 *(12) Spermicide; and*

46 *(13) Levonorgestrel and ulipristal acetate;*

47 *(e) [Providing or referring] The provision of or referral of persons for
48 preconception health services and assistance to achieve pregnancy; and*

1 (f) ~~Providing or referring~~ The provision of or referral of persons for testing
2 for and treatment of sexually transmitted infections.

3 3. Family planning services funded by a local governmental entity using a
4 grant awarded pursuant to this section may be provided wholly or partially
5 through a contract between the local governmental entity and another local
6 governmental entity, an agency of the State, a community health nurse, a
7 consultant or any other person or entity.

8 4. Family planning services funded using a grant awarded pursuant to this
9 section must be provided:

10 (a) In a manner that protects the dignity of the recipient;

11 (b) Without regard to religion, race, color, national origin, physical or
12 mental disability, age, sex, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation,
13 number of previous pregnancies or marital status; ~~and~~

14 (c) In accordance with ~~written~~ :

15 (1) Written clinical protocols that are in accordance with nationally
16 recognized standards of care ~~;~~

17 ~~;~~

18 (2) The provisions of 42 U.S.C. § 300(a) requiring a grantee to
19 encourage family participation, to the extent practical, in family planning
20 projects; and

21 (3) The provisions of Program Policy Notice 2014-01 issued by the Office
22 of Population Affairs of the United States Department of Health and Human
23 Services on June 5, 2014, prohibiting a grantee from requiring the consent of
24 parents or guardians for the provision of services to a minor or notifying the
25 parent or guardian of a minor before or after the minor has requested or received
26 family planning services, regardless of whether that Program Policy Notice is
27 superseded or revoked; and

28 (d) By persons who are required by NRS 432B.220 to report the abuse or
29 neglect of a child.

30 5. The Administrator may not use more than 10 percent of the money in the
31 Account to administer the Account.

32 ~~5.~~ 6. The Administrator shall award grants of money from the Account
33 based entirely on the need for family planning services in the community served
34 by the local governmental entity or the nonprofit organization and the ability of
35 the local governmental entity or nonprofit organization to effectively deliver
36 family planning services.

37 ~~6.~~ 7. The existence of the Account does not create a right in any local
38 government or nonprofit organization to receive money from the Account.

39 ~~7.~~ 8. As used in this section, "preconception health services" means the
40 promotion of proper health practices, screenings and interventions conducted
41 before pregnancy to identify and modify biomedical, behavioral and social risks
42 to a woman's health or pregnancy outcome through prevention and
43 management.

44 Sec. 6. 1. The Administrator may apply for and accept any gift, donation,
45 bequest, grant or other source of money for the purpose of awarding grants
46 pursuant to section 5 of this act. Any money so received must be deposited in the
47 Account.

48 2. The interest and income earned on money in the Account from any gift,
49 donation or bequest, after deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to
50 the Account.

51 3. Money from any gift, donation or bequest that remains in the Account at
52 the end of the fiscal year does not revert to the State General Fund, and the
53 balance in the Account must be carried forward to the next fiscal year.

1 Sec. 7. 1. A local governmental entity or nonprofit organization that
2 receives a grant pursuant to section 5 of this act shall:

3 (a) Inform a person to whom the entity or organization provides counseling
4 concerning family planning which is funded by a grant of any methods or
5 procedures that may be used to assist the person to achieve his or her goals
6 concerning family planning. The information must include:

7 (1) A clear explanation of family planning services, procedures,
8 prescriptions and devices available directly from the entity or organization and
9 those for which referral is required;

10 (2) A description of any risks of the method or procedure, including
11 possible negative outcomes and discomfort or pain that may result from using the
12 method or procedure;

13 (3) A description of the likely outcome and benefits of using the method
14 or procedure;

15 (4) A description of any alternative methods or procedures designed to
16 accomplish the same goal; and

17 (5) Answers to any questions the person has concerning the method or
18 procedure.

19 (b) Notify a person to whom the entity or organization provides counseling
20 concerning family planning which is funded by a grant that the person is free to
21 refuse any method or procedure about which the entity or organization informs
22 the person pursuant to paragraph (a).

23 2. Any personally identifiable information concerning a person to whom
24 services funded by a grant pursuant to section 5 of this act are provided is
25 confidential. A local governmental entity or nonprofit organization that receives
26 such a grant shall comply with all laws concerning the privacy of information,
27 including, without limitation, the Health Insurance Portability and
28 Accountability Act of 1996, Public Law 104-191, as amended, and applicable
29 regulations.

30 Sec. 8. 1. The State Board of Health shall adopt any regulations
31 necessary to carry out the provisions of sections 2 to 8, inclusive, of this act. The
32 regulations must establish, without limitation:

33 (a) The manner in which a local governmental entity or nonprofit
34 organization may apply for a grant pursuant to section 5 of this act; and

35 (b) A requirement that the recipient of a grant pursuant to section 5 of this
36 act must submit any information that the State Board of Health determines is
37 necessary for the Administrator to determine the purposes for which such a grant
38 was used and evaluate the outcomes of services provided using such grants.

39 2. The regulations adopted pursuant to this section must not require a local
40 governmental entity or nonprofit organization to apply for a grant pursuant to
41 section 5 of this act.

51 supply the general public with copies, abstracts or memoranda of the records or
52 may be used in any other way to the advantage of the governmental entity or of the
53 general public. This section does not supersede or in any manner affect the federal

1 laws governing copyrights or enlarge, diminish or affect in any other manner the
2 rights of a person in any written book or record which is copyrighted pursuant to
3 federal law.

4 2. A governmental entity may not reject a book or record which is
5 copyrighted solely because it is copyrighted.

6 3. A governmental entity that has legal custody or control of a public book or
7 record shall not deny a request made pursuant to subsection 1 to inspect or copy or
8 receive a copy of a public book or record on the basis that the requested public
9 book or record contains information that is confidential if the governmental entity
10 can redact, delete, conceal or separate the confidential information from the
11 information included in the public book or record that is not otherwise confidential.

12 4. A person may request a copy of a public record in any medium in which
13 the public record is readily available. An officer, employee or agent of a
14 governmental entity who has legal custody or control of a public record:

15 (a) Shall not refuse to provide a copy of that public record in a readily
16 available medium because the officer, employee or agent has already prepared or
17 would prefer to provide the copy in a different medium.

18 (b) Except as otherwise provided in NRS 239.030, shall, upon request, prepare
19 the copy of the public record and shall not require the person who has requested the
20 copy to prepare the copy himself or herself.

21 **Sec. 10.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval for the
22 purpose of adopting regulations and performing any other administrative tasks that
23 are necessary to carry out the provisions of this act and on January 1, 2018, for all
24 other purposes.
