AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the State Distributive School Account for ~~for a shortfall resulting from~~ an unanticipated shortfall in local school support tax revenues and an increase in K-12 enrollment for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 school years; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the State Distributive School Account created by NRS 387.030 the sum of ~~for \$22,217,169~~ \$62,194,642 for ~~for a shortfall resulting from~~ an unanticipated shortfall in local school support tax revenues and an increase in K-12 enrollment for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 school years. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 7 of chapter 537, Statutes of Nevada 2015, at page 3740.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
