AN ACT making appropriations to the Division of Public and Behavioral Health of the Department of Health and Human Services for a laboratory information system for the Southern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services and for an integrated medication management system for the Department; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the  
2       Division of Public and Behavioral Health of the Department of Health and Human  
3       Services the sum of \$293,774 for a laboratory information system to support on-site  
4       medical laboratory testing for the Southern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services.

5       **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the  
6       Division of Public and Behavioral Health of the Department of Health and Human  
7       Services the sum of \$1,653,039 for an integrated medication management system  
8       for the Department.

9       **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by sections 1 and  
10      2 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2019, by the  
11      entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the  
12      appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of  
13      the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after  
14      September 20, 2019, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or  
15      the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be  
16      reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 20, 2019.

17       **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective ~~on July 1, 2017,~~ **upon passage and**  
18      **approval.**
