AN ACT relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles; revising the provisions governing the requirements for the issuance of vintage license plates; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law provides that the Department of Motor Vehicles may produce and
2 issue vintage license plates to residents of Nevada for any motor vehicle
3 manufactured not later than 1942. This bill extends the date to qualify for vintage
4 license plates to motor vehicles manufactured not later than 1961.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 482.3818 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 482.3818 1. The Department may produce and issue vintage
4 license plates to residents of Nevada for any motor vehicle
5 manufactured not later than ~~1942~~ *1961*.

6 2. Vintage license plates issued pursuant to this section must be
7 produced by the Department:

8 (a) Using only digital technology for the production of the
9 plates; and

10 (b) To appear, insofar as is practicable, the same as the license
11 plates that were issued in Nevada during the year of manufacture of
12 the particular motor vehicle to which the vintage license plates will
13 be affixed.

1 3. The fee for vintage license plates issued pursuant to this
2 section is \$35, in addition to all other applicable registration and
3 license fees and governmental services taxes. The vintage license
4 plates are renewable upon the payment of \$10.

5 4. If, during a registration year, the holder of vintage license
6 plates issued pursuant to the provisions of this section disposes of
7 the vehicle to which the plates are affixed, the holder shall:

8 (a) Retain the plates and affix them to another vehicle that meets
9 the requirements of this section if the holder pays the fee for the
10 transfer of the registration and any registration fee or governmental
11 services tax due pursuant to NRS 482.399; or

12 (b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle,
13 return them to the Department.

14 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on January 1, 2018.
