

## SENATE BILL NO. 443—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

AN ACT making an appropriation for the transfer of four sign language interpreter positions contracted with the Aging and Disability Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services to state employee positions; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Aging and Disability Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of \$378,953.28 for the transfer of four sign language interpreter positions contracted with the Division to state employee positions beginning at grade 37, step 5.

**Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2019, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 20, 2019, by either the entity to which the money

- 1 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
- 2 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
- 3 Fund on or before September 20, 2019.
- 4 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2017.
