SUMMARY—Makes a supplemental appropriation to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety for a projected shortfall related to higher than anticipated costs for providing protective services for dignitaries visiting the State of Nevada. (BDR S-1182)

AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety for a projected shortfall related to higher than anticipated costs for providing protective services for dignitaries visiting the State of Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 2 Fund to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of
- 3 Public Safety the sum of \$34,358 for a projected shortfall related to
- 4 higher than anticipated costs for providing protective services for
- 5 dignitaries visiting the State of Nevada. This appropriation is
- 6 supplemental to that made by section 31 of chapter 534, Statutes of
- 7 Nevada 2015, at page 3676.
- 8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
