

SENATE BILL NO. 546—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

MAY 30, 2017

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Authorizes and provides funding for certain projects of capital improvement. (BDR S-1187)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No.

AN ACT relating to projects of capital improvement; authorizing certain expenditures by the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration; levying a property tax to support the Consolidated Bond Interest and Redemption Fund; making appropriations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration the sum of \$48,009,701 to support the Division in carrying out the program of capital improvements as summarized in this section. The amount is allocated to projects numbered and described in the Executive Budget for the 2017-2019 biennium or otherwise described as follows:

**Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

**Sec. 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration the sum of \$4,346,066 to support the Division in carrying out the program of capital improvements summarized in this section. The amount is allocated to projects numbered and described in the Executive Budget for the 2017-2019 biennium or otherwise described as follows:

**Sec. 4.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by section 3 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

**Sec. 5.** The amounts appropriated pursuant to section 3 of this act from the State Highway Fund must be allocated by the State Controller as the money is required for the projects and must not be transferred to the projects from the State Highway Fund until required to make contract payments.

**Sec. 6.** The State Board of Finance shall issue general obligation bonds of the State of Nevada in the face amount of not more than \$117,912,005 for the capital improvements summarized in this section. The amount is allocated to projects numbered and



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identified in the Executive Budget for the 2017-2019 biennium or otherwise described as follows:

15 **Sec. 7.** Any remaining balance of the allocated amounts  
16 authorized in section 6 of this act must not be committed for  
17 expenditure after June 30, 2021, and must be reverted to the Bond  
18 Interest and Redemption Account in the Consolidated Bond Interest  
19 and Redemption Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

20 **Sec. 8.** 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, the  
21 State Board of Finance shall issue general obligation bonds of the  
22 State of Nevada in the face amount of not more than \$42,016,797  
23 for the project numbered and identified in the Executive Budget for  
24 the 2017-2019 biennium and otherwise described as Project 17-C04,  
25 Construct New Department of Motor Vehicles Service Office, Reno.  
26 The provisions of the State Securities Law, NRS 349.150 to  
27 349.364, inclusive, apply to the bonds authorized by this subsection.

28 2. The State Board of Finance shall not issue the bonds  
29 described in subsection 1 unless the Board determines that the  
30 money budgeted or to be budgeted pursuant to subsection 3 will be  
31 sufficient to pay the bond repayment costs of the bonds authorized  
32 by subsection 1. In making its determination under this subsection,  
33 the State Board of Finance shall be entitled to rely on a certification  
34 of the Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the  
35 Governor that the money budgeted and to be budgeted pursuant to  
36 subsection 3 will be sufficient to pay the bond repayment costs of  
37 the bonds authorized by subsection 1. Any determination by the  
38 State Board of Finance under this subsection shall be conclusive. As  
39 used in this subsection, "bond repayment costs" means the principal  
40 of and interest on the bonds and any other costs related to the  
41 payment of the bonds or compliance with covenants made in  
42 connection with those bonds, as estimated by the State Treasurer.

43 3. The Legislature intends that 12.0 percent of the annual bond  
44 repayment costs of the bonds authorized by subsection 1, and any  
45 bonds directly or indirectly, through a series of refundings,



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1 refunding those bonds, will be paid from the Pollution Control  
2 Account created by NRS 445B.830, and 88.0 percent of those  
3 annual bond repayment costs will be paid from annually available  
4 money in the State Highway Fund. The Director of the Office of  
5 Finance in the Office of the Governor, the Director of the  
6 Department of Transportation and the Director of the Department of  
7 Motor Vehicles are hereby directed to budget for payment of such  
8 bond repayment costs from the sources and in the proportions stated  
9 in this subsection in each budget or other spending plan presented to  
10 the Legislature for the expenditure of amounts in the Pollution  
11 Control Account created by NRS 445B.830 and the State Highway  
12 Fund after the effective date of this section until the bonds  
13 authorized by subsection 1 and any bonds directly or indirectly  
14 refunding those bonds are no longer outstanding. The money so  
15 budgeted to pay the annual bond repayment costs of the bonds  
16 authorized by subsection 1, and any bonds directly or indirectly,  
17 through a series of refundings, refunding those bonds, are hereby  
18 appropriated in each year to the Consolidated Bond Interest and  
19 Redemption Fund to pay such bond repayment costs. As used in this  
20 subsection, "annually available money in the State Highway Fund"  
21 means money remaining in the State Highway Fund in any year  
22 after all amounts required to pay bonds issued pursuant to NRS  
23 408.273 in that year have been paid or provision for such payment  
24 has been made.

25 **Sec. 9.** Any remaining balance of the allocated amounts  
26 authorized in section 8 of this act must not be committed for  
27 expenditure after June 30, 2021, and must be reverted to the Bond  
28 Interest and Redemption Account in the Consolidated Bond Interest  
29 and Redemption Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

30 **Sec. 10.** 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, the  
31 State Board of Finance may issue general obligation bonds of the  
32 State of Nevada in the face amount of not more than \$41,500,000  
33 for the project numbered and identified in the Executive Budget for  
34 the 2017-2019 biennium and otherwise described as Project 17-C06,  
35 Construction of New Engineering Building, University of Nevada,  
36 Reno. The provisions of the State Securities Law, NRS 349.150 to  
37 349.364, inclusive, apply to the bonds authorized by this subsection.

38 2. The State Board of Finance shall not issue the bonds  
39 described in subsection 1 unless the Board determines that the  
40 money budgeted or to be budgeted pursuant to subsection 3 will be  
41 sufficient to pay the bond repayment costs of the bonds authorized  
42 by subsection 1. In making its determination under this subsection,  
43 the State Board of Finance shall be entitled to rely on a certification  
44 of the Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the  
45 Governor that the money budgeted and to be budgeted pursuant to



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1 subsection 3 will be sufficient to pay the bond repayment costs of  
2 the bonds authorized by subsection 1. Any determination by the  
3 State Board of Finance under this subsection shall be conclusive. As  
4 used in this subsection, "bond repayment costs" means the principal  
5 of and interest on the bonds and any other costs related to the  
6 payment of the bonds or compliance with covenants made in  
7 connection with those bonds, as estimated by the State Treasurer.

8 3. The Legislature intends that the annual bond repayment  
9 costs of the bonds authorized by subsection 1, and any bonds  
10 directly or indirectly, through a series of refundings, refunding those  
11 bonds, will be paid from the State General Fund. The Director of the  
12 Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor is hereby directed to  
13 budget for payment of such bond repayment costs from the source  
14 stated in this subsection in each budget or other spending plan  
15 presented to the Legislature for the expenditure of amounts in the  
16 State General Fund after the effective date of this section until the  
17 bonds authorized by subsection 1 and any bonds directly or  
18 indirectly refunding those bonds are no longer outstanding. The  
19 money so budgeted to pay the annual bond repayment costs of the  
20 bonds authorized by subsection 1, and any bonds directly or  
21 indirectly, through a series of refundings, refunding those bonds, are  
22 hereby appropriated in each year to the Consolidated Bond Interest  
23 and Redemption Fund to pay such bond repayment costs.

24 **Sec. 11.** Any remaining balance of the allocated amounts  
25 authorized in section 10 of this act must not be committed for  
26 expenditure after June 30, 2021, and must be reverted to the Bond  
27 Interest and Redemption Account in the Consolidated Bond Interest  
28 and Redemption Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

29 **Sec. 12.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
30 Fund the sum of \$1,037,500 for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 for the  
31 exclusive purpose of funding debt service payments for the general  
32 obligation debt authorized in section 10 of this act, and which sum  
33 cannot be used for any other purpose.

34 **Sec. 13.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
35 section 12 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
36 June 30, 2019, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or  
37 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or  
38 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the  
39 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose  
40 after September 20, 2019, by either the entity to which the money  
41 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
42 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General  
43 Fund on or before September 20, 2019.

44 **Sec. 14.** 1. The State Board of Finance may issue the bonds  
45 authorized pursuant to sections 6, 8 and 10 of this act at the time



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1 deemed appropriate by the Board based on the schedule established  
2 for the completion of the projects described in those sections.

3 2. The State Controller may advance temporarily from the  
4 State General Fund, upon the approval of the Director of the Office  
5 of Finance in the Office of the Governor, to the State Public Works  
6 Division of the Department of Administration, until the date on  
7 which the bonds authorized by sections 6 and 10 of this act are sold,  
8 amounts necessary to facilitate the start of the projects enumerated  
9 in sections 6 and 10 of this act. The amounts temporarily advanced  
10 by the State Controller must be made as the money is required for  
11 the projects and must not be transferred to the projects from the  
12 State General Fund until required to make contract payments. The  
13 advanced amounts must be repaid immediately to the State General  
14 Fund upon the issuance of the bonds or not later than the last  
15 business day in August immediately following the end of the fiscal  
16 year during which the advance is made.

17 3. The State Controller may advance temporarily from the  
18 State Highway Fund, upon the approval of the Director of the Office  
19 of Finance in the Office of the Governor, to the State Public Works  
20 Division of the Department of Administration, until the date on  
21 which the bonds authorized by section 8 of this act are sold,  
22 amounts necessary to facilitate the start of the project enumerated in  
23 section 8 of this act. The amounts temporarily advanced by the State  
24 Controller must be made as the money is required for the project  
25 and must not be transferred to the project from the State Highway  
26 Fund until required to make contract payments. The advanced  
27 amounts must be repaid immediately to the State Highway Fund  
28 upon the issuance of the bonds or not later than the last business day  
29 in August immediately following the end of the fiscal year during  
30 which the advance is made.

31 4. The Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the  
32 Governor shall provide written notification to the State Controller,  
33 the State Treasurer and the Senate and Assembly Fiscal Analysts of  
34 the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau  
35 of the approval of the advances from the State General Fund and the  
36 State Highway Fund to the State Public Works Division of the  
37 Department of Administration pursuant to subsections 2 and 3. The  
38 Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the Governor shall  
39 provide a reconciliation to the Senate and Assembly Fiscal Analysts  
40 of the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau of  
41 the advances authorized from the State General Fund and State  
42 Highway Fund and repayments to the State General Fund and the  
43 State Highway Fund made during any fiscal year during the 2017-  
44 2019 biennium. The reconciliation must be provided not later than



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1 the last business day in August immediately following the end of the  
2 fiscal year during which the advance is made.

The State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration shall not execute a contract for construction of a project listed in subsection 1 until the Division has determined that the funding authorized in subsection 1 for the project has been received and is available for expenditure for the project.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 4 of NRS 353.220, the approval of the Interim Finance Committee is not required for any request for the revision of a work program for any account within the Consolidated Bond Interest and Redemption Fund for the payment of principal, interest and related costs of issuance for securities approved by the State Legislature pursuant to the provisions of this act.

**Sec. 34.** 1. With the approval of the Interim Finance Committee, the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration and the Nevada System of Higher Education may transfer appropriated, allocated and authorized money from one project to another within the same agency or within the Nevada System of Higher Education for those projects listed in sections 1, 3, 6, 10, 15, 17, 19, 21 and 35 of this act.
