## SENATE BILL NO. 93-SENATOR HARDY

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to elections. (BDR 24-268)

EXPLANATION - Matter in bolded italics is new; matter between brackets formitted material is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to city elections; authorizing, under certain circumstances, the governing body of a charter city to conduct a city election in which all ballots must be cast by mail; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law authorizes the governing body of a city to conduct a city election in which all ballots must be cast by mail if the election: (1) is a special election; (2) involves only offices and ballot questions that may be voted on by the voters of only one ward of the city; or (3) involves only a single office or ballot question. (NRS 293C.112) This bill authorizes the governing body of a city incorporated under a special charter to conduct a city election in which all ballots must be cast by mail if the election is a primary city election or general city election and the election is held in an odd-numbered year.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** NRS 293C.112 is hereby amended to read as follows:

293C.112 1. The governing body of a city may conduct a city election in which all ballots must be cast by mail if:

- (a) The election is a special election; or
- (b) [The] Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, the election is a primary city election or general city election in which the ballot includes only:

- (1) Offices and ballot questions that may be voted on by the 2 registered voters of only one ward; or 3
  - (2) One office or ballot question.

- The governing body of a city incorporated pursuant to a special charter may conduct a city election in which all ballots must be cast by mail if:
- (a) The election is a primary city election or general city election; and
  - (b) The election is held in an odd-numbered year.
- 3. The provisions of NRS 293C.265 to 293C.302, inclusive, 293C.305 to 293C.340, inclusive, and 293C.355 to 293C.361, inclusive, do not apply to an election conducted pursuant to this section.
- [3.] 4. For the purposes of an election conducted pursuant to this section, each precinct in the city shall be deemed to have been designated a mailing precinct pursuant to NRS 293C.342.
  - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective:
- Upon passage and approval for the purpose of adopting any regulations and performing any other preparatory administrative tasks that are necessary to carry out the provisions of this act; and
  - 2. On January 1, 2018, for all other purposes.
