Section 5 of this legislation would create a 6-member Governmental Oversight and Accountability Subcommittee of the Legislative Commission. The Subcommittee would be authorized to fulfill many of the powers and duties imposed upon the Legislative Commission.

Although the legislation provides that the Subcommittee could meet not earlier than September 1 of each odd-numbered year and not later than August 31 of the following even-numbered year unless the Legislative Commission ordered the Subcommittee to meet at other times, the legislation would not require the subcommittee to meet any particular number of times in any biennium. Each meeting of the Subcommittee would cost approximately \$1,500.

The Governor's recommended budget includes \$30,000 for the costs of new statutory or interim studies for the 2017-18 Interim. The Legislative Operations and Elections Committees for the respective Houses of the Legislature will determine how that funding is used based on the interim studies and committees that are approved.

Section 10 of the legislation would expand the actions the Legislative Commission could take with respect to administrative regulations. It appears that the Commission would not need to conduct additional meetings if it elects to take the actions authorized in section 10.
