If enacted, it appears that this legislation could have a fiscal impact on the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE), specifically for the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV), Police Services. UNLV indicates that the police services department would need to install surveillance cameras, microphones, and computer hardware to film and archive interrogations in its interview rooms, as well as maintain a mobile interrogation software program for remote interview locations. Additionally, UNLV anticipates it will be necessary to replace hardware and upgrade computer software and licenses every three to five years. The University of Nevada, Reno (UNR) and the College of Southern Nevada (CSN) do not anticipate a fiscal impact. UNR already records major investigative reviews and is currently preparing a policy regarding this process; CSN already owns the required equipment.

BDR 14-600 requires the electronic recording of law enforcement interrogations during homicide and sexual assault investigations. This will present an on-going fiscal impact on the UNLV Department of Police Services. The department will need to install surveillance cameras, microphones, and computer hardware to film and archive interrogations in its interview rooms. The department will also need to maintain a mobile video interrogation software program for remote location interviews. Initial one-time costs for the purchasing of hardware and licenses will be \$25,790.00. Replacement of hardware and upgrading of computer software and licenses will run \$18,290.00 every three to five years.
