If enacted, it appears this legislation would have a fiscal impact on the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE) and its institutions. The proposed legislation requires the Board of Regents, or its designee, and the Commission on Post Secondary Education to collaborate with the American Council of Education to establish statewide standards for awarding (college) credit for military education, training or occupational experience. Additionally the proposed legislation would require that credits earned through military education, training, or service be applied toward coursework required for an associate's or baccalaureate degree or certificate at an NSHE institution. If enacted, NSHE would hire a consultant (contract or temporary FTE) for at least one year, to facilitate discussions among the various stakeholder groups, including public and private institutions in the state, to develop the statewide standards required through this legislation. Additional costs may be incurred in future fiscal years, as the resulting statewide standards are implemented through out the NSHE system.
