Passage of BDR 12-597 would authorize a new type of notarization in Nevada—remote notarization using live online audio and video recordings. In order to accommodate this new notarization type the Office of the Secretary of State would incur the following costs/revenue loss: 1. New customized functionality will need to be added to the Secretary of State's agency-wide database program. 2. This bill will require the Secretary of State to adopt regulations related to the provisions of this bill. Based on historical costs, the adoption of regulations will cost \$9,500. 3. A full-time permanent Administrative Assistant II position will need to be added to the Notary Division to support the additional labor necessary to assist and educate the public in this new program (see attached NEBS report). 4. Section 45 of the BDR removes the training requirement for an electronic notary from the current statute, resulting in an estimated net effect of a 5% loss of revenue annually.
