## **Explanation**

This bill creates a procedure for the establishment of paternity concerning a child in need of protection. Section 5 requires the division to be responsible for the cost of court ordered paternity tests. Federal financial participation under Title IV-D of the Social Security Act is available solely for cases receiving child support services. Most child protective cases are not funded under IV-D; therefore, paternity testing costs cannot be paid by the Child Support Enforcement Program. The division has not been able to determine a funding source which authorizes these costs; accordingly, any costs resulting from this bill may need to be funded with General Fund. At this time, the division cannot determine the fiscal impact, as data is not available to identify the potential volume of court ordered tests.
