BDR 19-1163 (AB476) section 10 provides that an electronic notary public who uses a document for which an authentication has been issued for the purposes of harassment or to accomplish any fraudulent, criminal or unlawful act is guilty of a C felony. Enactment of this bill as introduced would require staff of the General Services Division (GSD) to create 3 new sub-types, and create 3 new Nevada Offense Codes (NOCs). The impact cannot be determined until GSD calculates the cumulative total of all legislation from the 2017 session. GSD requests to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2017-2019 biennium should the cumulative workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
